
Introduction

Generate Debits and Credits

Create accounting records in the style of standard journal entries, with support for double entry journals – debits and credits.

Detailed Gift Allocations

Allocate gifts to specific funds at the level of detail needed to recognize donor intent. Accounting Subledger also supports cash and accrual accounting.


Accounting Periods

Open and close accounting periods to ensure that activity is reconciled and posted in both systems. Organize periods of time to match your accounting methods.


Integration with Nonprofit and Education Data

Accounting Subledger manages complex allocations across multiple programs, projects, and fiscal years – so that you can spend more time on raising money and growing your mission.


Unified View of Giving
